

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Athletes are expected to be committed to the program and respectful of their coaches and teammates.
- Players are responsible for notifying coaches of an absence.

- Players will notify the coach of any tournament conflict at least one month prior to the event.
 - If a player leaves a tournament it will be considered they are quitting the team.

- No boys are allowed in player's hotel room.
- Players must not leave their room after specified curfew time.
- Players and parents are responsible for leaving all gymnasiums clean.
- Players are responsible for leaving all hotel rooms clean.
